Last week I read this devotion from "Voices of the Faithful", and thought I would share it with you.

This is My Father's World "He is like the light of morning at sunrise on a cloudless morning, like the brightness after rain that brings the grass from the earth." 2 Samuel 23:4

"Living in the jungle is a learning experience. I've learned how to hotwire a solar panel, that approaching army ants signify coming rain and that pigs will eat anything you leave in the yard.

But one of my most treasured lessons from my jungle time concerns the beauty of God's creation. Without daylight savings time, the sunrise is early. When I go for a walk at 5:30 a.m., the sun begins to peek out, full of color. Every

morning I feel like God has created the sunrise for my pleasure. I feel like He says to me, I thought of you when I made this today. I couldn't wait to see your face when you saw it.


I found this same joy in creation in other areas of my walk. When I see a spider web, wet and glistening with dew, I feel like God put it there for me. When I see a leaf-cutter ant hauling his giant leaf home, I know it was there to make me smile. The parrots, the toucans and even the wild pigs are all brought by God into my path on these walks.

God's creation is all around us. He manifests Himself in every sunrise, in the flowers that open, in the insects busy at work and in the multitude of stars at night. Have you noticed? Have you given


