From Your Associational Missionary...

On Saturday, February 25th, our Association will host a Regional Children's Mission Extravaganza at Roopville Road Baptist Church from 10:00am until 3:30 pm. This "Mission Extravaganza is for children grades 1-6 and their leaders. They will have the opportunity to meet and talk with an IMB and a NAMB missionary, and hear about their ministry field. They will participate in 12-14 mission stations (hands-on ministry activities) around the Christian Life Center such as writing a letter to a missionary family, meeting the parents of some of our local IMB missionaries, and assisting local ministries in our area. They will also have an opportunity go out to do an actual mission/ ministry project within our community. This is going to be a very active day learning about and actually participating in missions. The cost is only \$20.00 a person which includes lunch and all the items needed for the stations

Why are we partnering with the Georgia WMU and Women's Ministry Ministries on this Mission Extravaganza? It's pretty simple—to assist you in teaching kids about missions in our community, state, nation and world. There is much being offered for our kids, but according to observations shared with me, one area that is lacking is Missions. February 25th gives you a chance to educate and encourage your children and leaders about missions.

I appreciate the adjustments Roopville Road made in their Upward Basketball Program in order to host this extravaganza—all because they recognized the importance and significance of Missions. and girls to one day become missionaries.




