It was an incredible week, a record week, and I'm grateful for Scottie and Steve Jennings and Pam and Mac Orange who served as our coordinators. They made sure every hour was covered, every box was counted, and every one who brought a box or boxes felt welcomed and appreciated. And thank you for taking the time to "pack a shoebox." That shoebox will make a great impact on some child's life in the days ahead.

The weekend of December 4th and 5th, Rev. Milford Ballenger and his wife, Joyce and myself along with a group of youth and adults from Indian Creek Baptist Church went to Rogersville, TN to assist with Christmas parties and help distribute gifts and backpacks. It was wonderful to see the expressions of each boy and girl as they received their backpack and their wrapped gifts. One little girl just had to look in one compartment of her backpack and she was excited by what she found. One of the highlights of the weekend though was that 5 people (3 adults and 2 children) prayed to receive Christ!

We have another team from Kansas going up December 11th and 12th to Rogersville, TN and a team from Mt. Pleasant going to Copper Hill, TN to distribute backpacks there. Overall almost 870 backpacks were collected for Appalachia from our Association. Thank you for your support of this mission project.




Sanctity of Human Life Day January 17th

From the WMU

I recently read an article on the WMU website. Wanda Lee, executive director of WMU, told the SBC Executive Committee "we're (WMU) grieving over the imminent downsizing of 600-800 missionaries and staff members in a multi-million-dollar shortfall confronting the International Mission Board." Lee reminded the committee of the insight of Annie Armstrong that is still important today. Annie said missions education first entails a study of God's Word. Then comes a study of the mission field, then prayer, then sacrificial giving for the advance of the Gospel. One thing Lee believes we have failed to do in our churches is to embrace the missions assignment of helping our children and our youth understand God's field. She continued to say

when there's "no understanding of the depth of lostness, there's no passion to give." Lee also said we have to do what Annie said years ago. We have to teach them God's Word. We have to help them see all of God's world the way He loves people and the way He desires for them to come to Him. When we feel that depth of conviction, we will pray like we've never prayed before, we will give sacrificially.

Lee said WMU will stand with and support our missionaries and be the best partner with IMB we can be. We can help returning missionaries find housing and be alerted to employment possibilities. WMU provides council to those who want to learn more about starting a missionary house ministry and facilitates communication between missionaries and those who have houses available for use. Lee mentioned, "if you have a home available to offer to missionaries as they transition back to the U.S. please contact WMU (state or national WMU office) so it can be added to the housing list. Transportation will also be a need."

I hope this article will help you understand the impact missions education can have on your life as well as the children. If we will begin or continue missions education in our churches I believe we will see a positive impact for missions giving. Please continue to pray for all missionaries as they make future decisions.
