From Your Associational Missionary...

Thank you so much for your response to the Backpacks for Appalachia and the Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes. We collected 959 backpacks (893 went to Rogersville, TN and 66 went to Copper Hill, TN) and 3,267 shoeboxes which will go all over the world. Last year the shoeboxes from the Atlanta Processing Center went to Belize, Peru, Haiti, Mali, Angola, Cameron and several other African countries as well as the Philippines and several undisclosed countries.

Recently (Dec. 2nd and 3rd) a mission team from Pleasant Ridge and Salem went to Rogersville, TN to distribute some of the backpacks at two Christmas parties. After the meal, a program was presented , the Gospel was shared and 12 individuals made decisions for Christ. It was an exciting time for our team to see how a backpack can help make a difference in a person's life. Thank you again for how you demonstrate your concern for concern for others.

Its hard to believe that it is 2017—where did 2016 go? But with a new year brings new mission opportunities! On January 22nd you will receive a baby bottle to kick off "Baby Bottle Boomerang" for the Pregnancy Resource Center. Last year those baby bottles filled with change, currency, or checks raised \$32,000 to help fund the ministry of the PRC. And according to their most recent statistics 199 babies lives have been saved during 2016. That's an incredible statistic and lets us know that by our support we are saving lives one baby at a time! The baby bottles will need to be returned by Sunday, February 12th to your church and we will collect them in the office beginning on February 13th.

Also in January, plans begin to be made for Galactic Starveyors VBS. Many of our churches have already purchased their VBS Starter Kit and are excited about this year's VBS. The Jump Start Conference for Directors and Pastors will be hosted by Royal Baptist Church in Newnan on Thursday night, January 26th from 7:00pm-8:30pm. This is a great free conference led by the Kids Groups & Faith Development staff of the Georgia Baptist Mission Board. Our Associational VBS conference will be Thursday night, April 20th at Mt. Pleasant. Make plans to have all of your VBS workers there and be sure to order all of your VBS materials through the Associational office.

One other event to be aware of is on Saturday, February 25th at Roopville Road Baptist Church from 10:00am until 3:30pm the Children's Mission Extravaganza for children in Grades -6. This will be an incredible event for children to learn about missions and to actually do missions in our community! The cost is \$20.00 which includes lunch, speakers, mission activities, and supplies. It's going to be a great day !







<u>Children's Missions</u> <u>Extravaganza</u>

I want to encourage you to make a commitment to bring children, grades 1-6, from your church to participate in hands-on mission projects and a chance to hear about ministries that help others. They will pray for the nations and meet missionaries. The Carrollton Baptist Association is partnering with the Georgia Baptist WMU office to plan this area missions event. This opportunity will allow children to share Christ's love in the community.

Who: Boys & Girls grades 1-6 and their adult leaders (Your church needs to supply 1 adult leader per 10 children) **Your church must provide its own supervision at all times AND transportation to and from community projects.

What: Experience mission & ministry projects in the community. Your group will be assigned to a local ministry such as: baking cookies and visiting fire stations; visiting nursing homes; doing yard work for shut-ins; etc. Once registered, groups will be sent an email with local mission/ ministry project assignments. When: February 25, 2017, 9:30 AM-3:30 PM; Roopville Road Baptist. The cost is \$20 per person, and includes lunch, ministry supplies and all program fees. You can register online at gabaptist.org/extra. Important things to know before you start:

- Each church will be asked to click the box to agree with the Indemnity Form (child protection) and give the staffers name; their position and church name.
- Parents or those with consent will be asked to check the Photo/video consent box for permission to take photos of their child.
- Be sure to give an email address for important updates or changes.
- We need the gender of the children in order to assign projects.
