From Your Associational Missionary:

Many of you are aware that several repairs had to be made to the pool at Rockridge in order to meet new regulations and be ready for all the summer activities. Those repairs have been completed and the boys and girls are definitely enjoying the pool during their summer camps. Back in May we asked that churches possibly set aside Sunday, May 19th as a day to ask each person in worship to give one dollar to help with the cost of these repairs. So far we have received \$5,052.49 from 14 churches and two individuals to help with these repairs. Thank you for your quick response to this need! I know that every child and adult who uses the pool is appreciative of your willingness to give. You will never know the difference you have made.

Let me list the 14 churches that have given so far: Salem, Glenloch, Beulah, Carrollton FBC, Pleasant Grove, Rocky Mount, Mountain View, Villa Rica FBC, Midway West, Pleasant View, Pleasant Ridge, Tyus, Midway Macedonia, and Temple FBC. I know of several other churches who have collected money, but we have not received it.

It's not too late to give toward these pool repairs because the total cost of these repairs was over \$12,000. More repairs will be needed after the summer to meet all the new regulations.

Let me also thank everyone who participated in SPLASH: (Show People Love and Share Him,) May 30th-June 1st. Many ministry projects were completed in our community. Projects were done at Roopville Elementary, Mt. Zion Middle, Bowdon Elementary, Bowdon Middle, Baptist Collegiate Ministry Center at the UWG, Pregnancy Resource Center, Rockridge, and a block party/basketball tournament at Knox Park. Thank vou to Chris Altman, our Associational Youth Director, who helped to coordinate all of these projects and to Roopville Road, Harmony, Rocky Mount, Pleasant View, Antioch, and Consolation who worked hard at each location.

Thank you also for your participation in our VBS Mission Projectproviding non perishable goods for "Of One Accord Ministries" in Rogersville, TN. Several churches have already brought their collection of food by the office so we are beginning to resemble a food distribution warehouse! Our goal is to deliver the food items that were collected during our June VBS on Monday, July 1st and again in late July after the July VBS ends. Thank you for your willingness to give to such a great need.

My wife and I led the team, one of our students participated, and three of the professional medical personnel came from the UWG clinic. We had a

great team that really worked hard doing Medical clinics in Leogane, Haiti. We saw over 470 patients in just four days. We also were able to share the Gospel with all of the patients that we saw and 13 of them accepted Christ for the first time. Our medical personnel were able to treat a variety of ailments some of which were very

serious. It is great to see how God has enabled a way for the ministry that began after the earthquake through Georgia Baptists to be continued through Baptists 4 Haiti. Please pray for this ministry and the people we ministered to during our time in Haiti! God Bless, Bill
