Church Planting Trailer—\$10,000. Covered trailer with everything a new church start needs to begin services.

Portable Baptistry—\$4,000. A baptistry that can be carried to the churches for baptisms.

Block Party Trailer—\$5,000. A covered trailer with everything needed for a church to host block parties or other events throughout the year.

We are going to make the first need, the Church Planter Trailer, our VBS project. I hope you will join us to help make a difference in Washington. Dan

From the WMU

Last month I shared some servant evangelism ideas you could do to make a difference and have an impact on others. This month I thought I would share some ideas written for families. Angie Quantrell, author of *Families on Mission* (Ideas for Teaching Your Preschooler to Love, Share, and Care) shares through eleven chapters how to help your family experience ways to serve others. She believes families are the perfect setting for teaching how to get along, how to love, how to forgive, how to share, and how to care for others. It is a wonderful place to learn how to communicate and share feelings and ideas with others. Quantrell suggests that you talk with your family about serving others—being on mission for God. Explain why it is important to do what you are going to do. Each chapter contains a short explanation about the topic and then gives ideas for activities and projects that relate to that topic. Below are a few of the ideas the

author suggests for serving in your neighborhood.

Walk & Greet Others in Your

Neighborhood: Get to know your neighbors.

Just Passing By, Waving & Greeting:

As you drive to work, school, or to run errands smile & wave to your neighbors.

Welcome Door Sign: Have a door decoration that says God Bless You, Jesus Loves You, etc.

Play in the Front Yard: Play with your child, chat with people who walk by. Invite children to come play for a few minutes.

Holiday Treats: Deliver a plate of Home-baked cookies or treats that your family made. Attach a card that conveys holiday greetings. Include a Bible verse about Jesus' birthday.

Pray for Your Neighbors

Family Bible Study: Begin a family Bible Study at your home. Plan a short, family-oriented Bible story, a Bible

verse reading, sharing prayer request, and prayer.

Family Loss Support: Reach out to neighborhood families that have a loss of a family member. Make a casserole or dessert. Offer prayer help, or even babysitting. Show neighborly concern & helpfulness. Share how the Lord has helped you through similar situations.

Summer Family Play Day: Invite your neighbors to a family play day hosted in your yard (or a local park). Arrange preschooler-friendly activities like finger painting, wading pool, hula hoops, etc. Have a rest quilt in the shade with books/puzzles about Jesus.

There are several other chapters with suggestions on Praying, Giving, Caring, Praying, etc.
