From Your Associational Missionary...

As most of you are aware, the last several weeks for our family have been a whirlwind of activity with the unexpected death of Donna's mom. Donna flew to Greensboro early one Sunday morning to spend some time with her mom after she had been diagnosed with a fractured vertebrae in her lower back and the next morning was calling 911 for help and a trip to the ER. In a matter of a few hours, after a cat scan, everyone realized that her condition was much more serious and she was given only a few days to live. So instead of considering some assisted living places for potential rehab she and her brother had to begin to think about funeral arrangements. Donna's Mom was ready to go-she definitely had an active faith in her Lord, and so early on Friday morning she breathed her last breath and her faith became sight. The door to this earthly life was closed but the door to her heavenly home was opened!

As you can imagine her fu-

neral service was a time of celebration-in fact it was a Sunday night worship service. Her sister and nephew from Texas sang, as well as the church choir, and we sang several of her favorite hymns. I had the honor of sharing the "remembrance message" and shared some stories but mainly shared from her Bible some of her favorite scriptures. After the service we had a time of fellowship and heard many more stories from friends and family, especially from nieces and nephews who had traveled from several states to be there. Yes, it was a sad time for us, but I kept thinking of the verse—"For to me to live is Christ, but to die is gain."

Thank you for all of your prayers for our family and for all the calls, texts, and cards of sympathy and encouragement. We have felt His strength and peace during these days as the Great Shepherd and Comforter have been with us each step of the way. Continue to pray for Donna and her younger brother, Del, as they make decisions about the house and posses-

sions. We are grateful for each of you and your concern for our family.

This year not only will you have two new activities to enjoy—archery tag and a low ropes course, but we will also have missionaries in residence for the first time—John and Sonia Grady.
