The response to the "Buckets of Hope" project for Haiti has been absolutely incredible. I already know of over 600 buckets that have been purchased and we are making plans in our office to be the local warehouse for them. As you know the deadline to have the buckets to the associational office is Monday, March 8th by 5:00 p.m. We already have a truck lined up to carry them to Macon on Tuesday, the 9th so we will load those buckets up early Tuesday morning and head to Macon. Also remember that the shipping cost for each bucket is \$10.00 and we are asking each church to write one check to the association and we will write one check to the GBC (GA Baptist Disaster Relief). Thank you so much for your efforts in this project.

If you have some folks who would like to volunteer on Tuesday morning, March 9th, to help load the truck, I know we could use their help. I am expecting over 600 buckets from our churches that will need to be loaded that day.

On Saturday, March 13th we are partnering with the Mission's Volunteer Ministries to host an Acts 1:8 Missions Challenge at Roopville Road. It will be an opportunity to hear presentations on your Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the world led by representatives from the IMB, NAMB, GBC and local association. You will have a chance to visit with some of our churches who have been involved in Missions as well as see displays. We will also have a worship service to conclude our morning celebration. According to the 2009 Annual Church Profile we had over 4000 people involved in missions locally (Jerusalem), state (Judea), nationally (Samaria), and internationally (the world) which is the best year ever for our association. Yet there is so much more to be done so I pray that this event will challenge us even more to be His witnesses as "we are going."




