# From Your Associational Missionary...

On March 28th through the 31st, our association is hosting a group of church planters and their families at Rockridge Conference Center and Camp. These 23 families (44 adults and 43 children) are planting churches near military bases in the U.S. and Japan. They are part of the Praetorian Project Network and we are honored to host them for their annual retreat. These families come from Jacksonville, NC, Washington, DC and surrounding areas, Southern California, Hawaii, and one family departing Rockridge on Thursday the 31st for Okinawa, Japan to plant a church there. Our goal is to provide a time of rest and relaxation for them and an opportunity to recharge and reconnect with others involved in this incredible ministry to the military.

We became aware of this church planting movement in

March 2015 when several from our association went to Washington, DC for a vision trip. We had an opportunity to meet two of the planters and spend time with them. Then, in the fall, FBC Villa Rica returned to one of the plants and assisted with an event. As we talked with the Send Now Coordinator, Clint Clifton, who is also very involved with these church plants, he mentioned they were searching for a place to have a retreat in 2016. When we mentioned Rockridge to him, he was excited about the possibility. And in March it will become a reality.

It's going to be a great week! Our association will provide childcare on Wednesday so they can go to NAMB to meet leaders there; Keith Hamilton from GBMB will provide financial counseling for couples who have requested it; and Dr. Ron Huggins, Rev. Gary Greene, and Rev. Steve Schneider will be meeting with couples and providing marriage enrichment counseling. I am excited about the opportunity to meet, encourage and pray with these men and women and to see how we as an association and a network of churches can partner with them in the days ahead.

Please be in prayer for this incredible week at Rockridge. Also be thinking how your church might adopt one of these families to pray for and encourage.

As you can tell by this newsletter, there are a myriad of events happening in our association in March and April Remember especially Thursday, April 14th our Associational VBS Clinic at Mt. Pleasant.

The missionary's country of service, stability, freedom, governmental leaders, passports, visas, work permits, etc.
