## From Your Associational Missionary...

I will always remember August 26, 1988. Donna was expecting our second child. I was at our church camp near the Ocoee River on a staff retreat for FBC Cleveland, TN. Her parents had arrived the day before to visit and to help with a 3rd birthday party for Jonathan. I was preparing breakfast for the staff when the phone rang in the camp kitchen. Thinking it was probably the church office (who else had that number), I picked it up and to my surprise it was Donna's Mom. "Dan we are on the way to the hospital. Donna is having some problems so we are taking her. We think the baby is on the way." Imagine my surprise to hear those words especially since the baby was not due for another month—late September. I quickly hurried to my cabin, alerted our staff, packed up my stuff, and headed to the hospital which was at least an hour away. However the first part of the journey was not by car but by boat. Dr. Gene Mims loaded us all in his boat and headed to the Ocoee Inn where our church treasurer, "Chief", was waiting for the second leg of the journey. He drove me quickly to Cleve-

land. When I arrived Donna was being checked in. It was great to see her and it was exciting to know that our second child might be born shortly.

But a problem arose. The doctors discovered that Donna had developed toxemia and would not be able to have an epidural. It was important that the baby be born as soon as possible. Fortunately she was already in labor and in a few hours, gave birth to a 3lb., 6oz. little boy whom we named David Wayne. She was unable to hold her new son as they whisked him off to ICU and then gave her a shot that knocked her out for 24 hours. I walked to ICU later and saw David with tubes in his head, breathing peaceably but knew the next 24 hours for both of them were critical. I remember leaving the hospital around 9:30 pm that evening wondering what the next day held but knowing that God was present with them both and was watching over them.

When I arrived back at the hospital the next day, Donna was still resting and David was still in ICU. She woke up about noon and doctors were pleased with her progress. David was breathing on his own—lungs were good and doctors felt he was going to make it. I felt relieved and thankful for

God's protection for both David and Donna. Donna was dismissed two days later. David was dismissed 3 and 1/2 weeks later weighing 4 lbs and 4 ounces.

Now 24 years later David has graduated from Shorter University, has traveled to several countries on mission trips and international studies, served as a BCM campus intern at the University of West GA, and now is employed at Shorter University. He will begin a new journey on Saturday, November 17th as he marries Maegan Wallin whom he met at Shorter and has dated for over two years. We are excited for them and grateful that God brought them together. This is also a new journey for us (having a daughter-in-law) but we know God has a wonderful plan for them. We look forward to how God is going to use them in the days ahead. I know they would appreciate your prayers for them as they begin this new pilgrimage together.

May you and your family have a wonderful Thanksgiving.

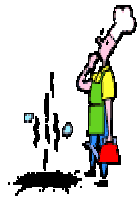
