From Your Associational Missionary...

Three weeks ago, 21 people from 6 of our churches— Tabernacle, Roopville Road, Oak Grove, FBC Villa Rica, Pleasant Grove and Mt. Pleasant-traveled to Walker, LA to assist the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association in cleaning up after the devastating flood. In talking with Rev. David Brown, DOM, he shared with me that 16 churches and 10 Pastors' homes had suffered severe flood damage in his Association. He asked if we could "adopt" the Gray's Creek Baptist Church. Our team spent 3 days assisting the church in "gutting" out their sanctuary and education space. They worked hard removing all the sheetrock, paneling, carpet, stage, piano and organ from the sanctuary and all the paneling, insulation, flooring and all the contents from the education space. When they left, the only things remaining were

the outside walls, the studs for the inside walls, the windows, and thankfully the ceilings. It was definitely a team effort and an incredible opportunity for churches and individuals from all ages (from 14 to 80) to work together. Ι am grateful for Chuck Griffith our disaster relief coordinator, who led the team and brought a group with him, and for Brady West, Youth Minister at Mt. Pleasant, who brought a team of youth and adults. I am also grateful for Gray's Creek Baptist who provided lunch and for Live Oak Baptist who provided lodging, meals and showers. I am also thankful for you and your response! We carried 51 buckets of care to help "mud out" homes which we gave to a disaster relief team. I handed Rev. Brown a check for over \$13,000 from our Flood

Assistance Fund! He was overwhelmed to say the least. Last week we mailed the association a check for over \$11,000 and yesterday we received checks for over \$2,000 more. So the overall total given by our churches and individuals is now **\$26,947.86**. That money is already being used to buy building supplies for the rebuilding process. Thank you! Thank you! Thank you!

Please make plans to come to the Annual Meeting/ Mission Celebration on Sunday night, October 16th, at 6:00 p.m. at Tabernacle. Dr. Robert White, Executive Director of the GBMB will be our guest speaker. We will conclude the evening with a prayer of dedication for all the backpacks! So come join us! Let's "pack" Tabernacle and celebrate what God has done.


Carroll County Law Enforcement Appreciation Day The Amp at Adamson Square Downtown Carrollton 10-Noon Tuesday, October 11, 2016
