We have given out over 1,000 backpacks for the Christmas Backpacks for Appalachia and we are still getting calls for more! Last year we carried 1,269 backpacks to Rogersville and Copper Hill, TN and I am anticipating even more this year based upon the response so far! I look forward to seeing all those Christmas backpacks brought to Mt. Pleasant on Sunday night, October 21st for our Annual Meeting/Mission Celebration.

This year when you bring your backpack to Mt. Pleasant we will load them in the truck instead of carrying them into the sanctuary. Although it is an incredible sight to see all the backpacks around the altar and the front of the church, it becomes chaos at the end as we take the backpacks from the altar to load the truck. So when you arrive at Mt. Pleasant we will have the truck waiting for you with people there to help you unload. We will also have

someone there to get an accurate count so we can announce at the meeting how many have been collected. We are also asking that each church bring in one backpack to the celebration so that we can pray over the backpacks at the end.

Thank you for your willingness to participate in this incredible project. Last year 99 decisions for Christ were made in Rogers-ville and surrounding areas.

Many of you have been asking about Disaster Relief Training/ Orientation for several weeks. We were finally able to schedule this for Thursday night, October 11th from 6 to 9 at Tabernacle Baptist Church. Registration will begin at 5. You will need to register online at missiongeorgia.org. The deadline to register is October 4th. This training will be especially helpful as we prepare to send out teams to assist the folks in North Carolina following Hurricane Florence. If you are interested in working with

Disaster Relief you need to attend this orientation and training. It is required for all Disaster Relief volunteers. You can also be recertified at this training if your certification has expired. Dr. Stuart Lang, Director of Disaster Relief Ministries at the GA Baptist Mission Board, will be our trainer.

I look forward to seeing you at our Annual Meeting/Mission Celebration at Mt. Pleasant on Sunday night, October 21st at 6:00 p.m. Rev. Buck Burch, GAMB state Missionary for the Cooperative Program and former IMB missionary to Russia, will be our guest speaker. We had Rev. Burch at one of our mission conferences several years ago and he did an outstanding job. I know he will definitely challenge us.

I hope you are already planning to attend this wonderful evening. It's a great way to celebrate what God has done this past year.
