1008. 42 cases. That's the number of backpacks that have been ordered for the Backpacks for Appalachia Mission Project. I had ordered 35 cases or 840 backpacks in June and they were all given out by the first week of August. This week, three more churches inquired, so 7 more cases-168 backpacks—were ordered. The goal for our association is 1,000 backpacks. So, if all 1008 are returned we will definitely reach our goal. Last year 870 backpacks were collected and distributed in Rogersville, TN and Copper Hill, TN. We will again carry them to these two locations.

The backpacks are due on October 16th at our Annual Meeting/Mission Celebration at Tabernacle. They will be placed around the altar and we will pray over them asking God to use these backpacks to make a difference in someone's life. If you packed a backpack, I would encourage you to join us at Tabernacle

for our time of celebration and dedication. Dr. Robert White will be our guest speaker and it will definitely be a celebration! You do not have to be a messenger to attend. Our business session will last about 5 minutes—messengers will vote at that time, but the rest of the evening is a worship/celebration time. On Monday we will carry all the backpacks to Rogersville.

If you would like to see a video about the impact of a backpack go to either www.gabaptist.org or to the Carrollton Baptist Association Facebook page and you can watch a two minute video. I hope you will share it at church and with your friends. The more who see it, the more backpacks we will receive.

Last year several of our churches went up to Rogers-ville in December to distribute the backpacks. During our two weekends (4 parties/distribution) 10 people made

decisions for Christ. Overall 52 decisions were made during the month at the various parties/ distribution. This year we have scheduled the first 3 weekends (Friday-Saturday) for teams to go up. The first weekend has already been taken but the other two weekends are available. If you would be interested in taking a team, please let me know.

Thank you for the incredible response to our Load the Truck for the GA Baptist Children's Home mission project. We have participated in this project for several years and I can tell you this—we far exceeded the number of items we have ever received. Several people packed boxes and boxes of food on Monday and several came to help load on Tuesday. I am grateful for your generosity in meeting the needs of these children and youth.

As we close another associational year let me just say—
Thank you for your faithfulness in praying, going, and giving.

Financial Assistance

We have been in contact with the Eastern Louisiana Baptist Association in Walker, LA. They serve the Livingston Parish (county) just east of Baton Rouge. According to their DOM 75% of the homes there have suffered flood damage. As of Saturday, he knew of 17 SBC churches and 9 Pastors' homes that were damaged. Their greatest need is financial because most churches and homes had no flood insurance. If your church would like to take up a love offering on August 28th or September 4th, we will make sure it gets to this association to help them assist churches and pastors. 100% of the money collected will go to assist them.

From the WMU

I wanted to share with you one way to support Georgia WMU. The Esther Fund (formerly known as the Special Projects budget) supports WMU ministries, such as Christian Women's/Men's Job Corps, mission trip scholarships, seminary scholarships, Sisters Who Care, language ministries, Camp Pinnacle, and more.

Each year a budget is developed for the Esther Fund. Each area of the budget or designation of funds receives a certain percentage of what is given. The goal for 2016 is \$40,000. GA WMU has only received about half that amount. If all churches around the state contributed to the fund the goal could be reached. If the goal is not reached it limits the funds available for the designated areas. I have placed a link to the Esther Fund 2016 Goal on the carrollton-wmu.com website.

If you just can't decide what you love most about GA WMU, support all of it through the Esther Fund.

Throughout the year I usually like

to remind you that we're available to help you start missions education in your church for preschoolers, children, students and adults. Maybe you already have Wednesday night programs, but we could help you think "outside the box" and think of a different time to teach them.
