Claude King in his book, Come to the Lord's Table, shares some thoughts and scriptures about what Jesus accomplished by the shedding of His blood on the cross.

- He bought the church. (Acts 20:28)
- He justified us (declares us righteous). (Romans 5:9)
- He brought us near. (Eph. 2:13)
- He made peace between God and us. (Col. 1:19-20)
- He cleansed our consciences from acts that lead to death. (Heb. 9:14)
- He purified us from all sin. (I John 1:7)
- He freed us from our sins. (Rev.

From the W.M.U.

I want to share with you all the results from our Operation Christmas Child Shoebox collection this past year. I recently got this information from Franklin Graham and I think all of you would like to know the magnitude of this project. In 2009 Operation Christmas Child collected 8.2 million shoebox gifts—the most ever. These were collected in 13 countries in 2009 including the very first ones from Spain and Hong Kong. This is almost 200,000 more than the previous year. The boxes were sent to 108 countries, including Guinea Bissau and St. Kitts for the first time. Since 1993, Operation Christmas Child has collected and distributed more

than 77 million shoebox gifts.

These boxes represent hope and joy across the globe. I am so glad we have been a part of this effort in our association since 1999. At the end of last year we had collected a total of 28,373 boxes. When you think of this in terms of children who have had joy at getting a gift, it takes on a whole new meaning. It's not just a box! Thank you to all who have helped in any way during the years to make this such a wonderful event. Many are won to Jesus through just a simple box of gifts that says to them, someone, somewhere loves me. In the box is literature that tells them Jesus loves them also. To God be

the glory!
