

From the WMU...

As December and 2012 come to an end my mind still reflects on our Lottie Moon Christmas Offering. Our offering supports international missions. Every penny of the offering goes to the International Mission Boardøs overseas budget, supporting our missionaries and their work. Do you know how this offering began?

Lottie Moon, whom the offering was named for, was a hardworking, deep-loving Southern Baptist who served tirelessly so her people group could know Jesus. Lottie served 39 years as a missionary, mostly in Chinaøs Shantung province. She taught in a girlsøschool and often made trips into Chinaøs interior to share the good news with women and girls. Throughout her career, Lottie Moon wrote numerous letters home, urging Southern Baptist to greater missions involvement and support. One of those letters triggered Southern Baptistø first Christmas offering for international missionsô enough to send three new missionaries to China.

December 24, 2012, will mark 100 years since the death of Lottie Moon. She was influential in other missionaries lives. They followed her example of going boldly, obediently and sacrificially.

You can find more information about Lottie Moon on the WMU website (wmu.com) and the IMB website (imb.org). There are some great resources to use in your church and with each age level group. Your church may have received a resource kit for the Lottie Moon Offering. Even though your church may be coming to the end of this offering focus the materials are still relevant to share with church members. If you dongt have the kit you can find the materials online at imb.org. There are video stories, missionary testimonies and other materials. You can also contribute online.

Seeing these mission stories may spark some excitement and interest in continuing learning about missions in North America and around the world. Our WMU team would be glad to talk with you and help you find materials to support missions education in your church.
