We have distributed through our office, over 500 backpacks to our churches and I look forward to seeing them being brought to the Annual Meeting.

World Hunger Fund offering on October 12th. Those funds are not only used around the world but also locally as well. I came across this story from IMB's "weekly prayer highlights" from Cape Town, South Africa that might be useful as you promote this offering in your church.

"The Southern Baptist World Hunger Fund approved the feeding project for 88 of my refugee students and their families." writes missionary Gail Davis. "When the vendor delivered the food to us. it was a mass of food greater than any the mind could picture! After days of sorting, the day of distribution arrived. The anticipation was great. The people didn't know what they would be receiving. The excitement and tension was so great that the people were giddy, which made them chatter and move around like a child waiting to open the unknown gifts on Christmas morning. They had a sparkle in their

eves. At last the moment arrived. As we called their names, the family groups came forward and were given their food. They immediately clapped, cried, praised God, and jumped with joy. They saw that the God about whom the missionary had been teaching loved them so much that He provided, through His children, three meals a day for a month for each person in each family. They would no longer need to fight for the last two tablespoons of oatmeal, because each person would now have his or her own and it would be enough. Thank you for contributing to the World Hunger Fund. Praise God for His provision and for leading you to give."

Also remember October is the month to recognize your Pastor and Staff in appreciation for all they do.
