

From The WMU

All for You Surrender*Sacrifice*Serve WMU Emphasis for 2014-2016

In 2014-2016, WMU will lead Christ followers to *surrender* completely by denying self; *sacrifice* willingly by taking up their cross; and *serve* intentionally by following Christ into their community, state, and world.

The Watchword is: "Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: 'Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me' " (Mark 8:34 NIV) During 2014-2016, WMU will address post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) as the Project HELP issue. We have been focused on human exploitation topics for the last four years and don't want to forget about what we have learned. We should continue praying and supporting programs we learned about that ministers to those who have been affected. It is possible that many of the people who have been directly affected by human exploitation could have developed PTSD.

Jessica Hamblen, who wrote a handout about PTSD, states that PTSD is "an anxiety disorder that can occur following the experiences or witnessing of a traumatic event." These events may be "military combat, natural disasters, terrorist incidents, serious accidents, or physical or sexual assault in adult or childhood." An article by Mayo clinic staff states other kinds of events may also lead to PTSD: "fire,...mugging, robbery, assault, civil conflict, car accident, plane crash, torture, kidnapping, life threatening medical diagnosis," and more.

No matter what the situation is, the church can be or become a loving and supporting community who cares. WMU will address the issue in age-appropriate ways, through age-level magazines, the WMU website, nd other resources. If you would like me to help you locate these resources please let me know.
