That is absolutely incredible! Thank you for your incredible response to this ministry project for the Pregnancy Resource Center. I look forward to seeing all those bottles returned filled with money (change, bills, or

a check) to benefit this much needed ministry in our community. Let me share with you the 2010 Pregnancy Resource Center Stats:

- 860 clients ministered to
- 624 were new clients
- 622 positive pregnancy test and 99% of those clients chose life
- 453 clients were single
- There were 10 decisions for Christ and the gospel was shared with every client who came into the center.
